USA Field Hockey is the National Governing Body for Field Hockey in the USA and is a member of the United States Olympic Committee. As a National Governing Body we are charged with the responsibility to represent the USA in the Olympic Games. The Journey starts with Futures.

Trials for the Futures 2011 starts with asking your coach to run you though a standardized test and recommend you for the 2011 program. Test results and recommendations will be reviewed and invitations will be sent to the qualifying athletes. You must be at least 12 years old to participate.
